Transnational project meeting in Poland

On 23-24 May 2023 the project team met in person in Łódź (Poland) by the partner institute Wyższa Szkoła Biznesu i Nauk o Zdrowiu.

During the meeting, the partners had the opportunity to share the evaluation of the results of the focus groups conducted in all project countries.

Based on the analysis of the findings, the team defined the structure of the GENDER 101 training programme and all following organisational arrangements leading to the production of the training.

The GENDER 101 learning programme for trainers and parents



The GENDER 101 team put in place specific activities to determine what people truly need to know.

To this purpose, focus groups with parents and educators and trainers have been carried out in the six project countries in the first quarter of 2023 to identify what information they would need to know about gender as parents and as trainers working with parents. Following these focus groups, during the Transnational Project meeting in Poland all collected data has been analysed and a Masterclass Plan was created. Executing this Plan, each project partner has developed one masterclass of 2 hours, thus creating a 6-class programme. The created content has been reviewed by three experts in the field in each country.

The goal of the Train the Trainers activity of the Gender 101 project was to allow trainers to receive the knowledge and trainers to become trained on the topic.

In the period June-July 2023, the GENDER 101 partners organize Masterclasses in all project countries Malta, Lithuania, Poland, Ireland, Italy and Croatia. Three educators in each country attend the training. In the following months, each of these trained trainers will deliver dedicated learning to 20 parents (totally 360 parents, 60 in each project country).
